First Aid Guidelines For Cleaning Chemicals



Eye contact. If in eyes, hold eyelids apart and flush the eyes continuously with running water. Remove contact lenses if easy to do so. Continue flushing until advised to stop by the Poisons Information Centre or a doctor, or for at least 15 minutes. Seek immediate medical attention and refer to SDS.



Skin contact. Remove all contaminated clothing immediately. Wash affected area thoroughly with soap and water. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse or discard. Seek medical attention and refer to SDS.



Inhalation. If inhaled, remove affected person from contaminated area. Keep at rest until recovered. If symptoms develop and/or persist seek medical attention, refer to SDS.
CAUTION- do not inhale the patient's exhaled air.



Ingestion. Do NOT induce vomiting. Refer to the label and SDS. Then contact the Poisons Information Centre or seek medical attention immediately. In most cases you should give a glass of water. A swallowed chemical that burns on the way down will burn on the way up.



Chemical Spill. Effected surfaces may become slippery, be aware and careful to avoid secondary accidents. If a flammable product is spilled, extinguish all fire ignition sources, naked flames and turn off any mechanical equipment. Refer to the SDS for further instructions.

Make sure you are familiar with the safety and first aid instructions on the Safety Data Sheets of all the products you are using.
